

Documents Needed

To complete your 2009-10 FAFSA, you will need the following financial information.

- Your Social Security Number (can be found on Social Security card)
- Your driver's license (if any)
- Your (and your spouse's, if you are married) 2008 W-2 Forms and Federal Income Tax Return - IRS Form 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ, foreign tax return, or tax return for Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, the U.S. Virgin Islands, the Marshall Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia or Palau. If you have misplaced your copy of the 2008 taxes, please go to www.byui.edu/financialaid/tax%20request.htm to find out how to get a copy.
- Your parents' 2008 W-2 Forms and Federal Income Tax Return (if you are a dependent student)
- Your (and your parents' if you are a dependent student) 2008 untaxed income records - Social Security, Temporary Assistance to Needy Families, welfare, or veterans benefits records
- Your (and your parents' if you are a dependent student) most recent bank statements
- Your (and your parents' if you are a dependent student) most recent business and investment mortgage information, business and farm records, stock, bond, and other investment records
- Your alien registration number or permanent residence card (if you are not a U.S. citizen)

To organize your information, print and complete a FAFSA on the Web Worksheet before you begin entering your information online.
