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## Pell Grants & University Aid

### Financial Aid Determination Date

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**Before January 26, 2012:**

- If you **drop all of your Winter 2012 classes** any time before midnight on Jan. 26, 2012 — Your Pell Grants, university scholarships, and/or university grants will be canceled and you will be required to return all funds.
  
- If you are **carrying less than the minimum** required credits (12 credits for full Pell Grants and university grants, 14 credits for scholarships) as of midnight on Jan. 26, 2012, and you have a:
  - **University Scholarship** - The entire amount of your scholarship will be canceled and you will be required to return all funds.
  
  - **Pell Grant and/or University Grant** - The amount of your Pell Grant and/or university grant will be prorated according to the change in credits. If you drop below the six-credit minimum for grants, your grant will be canceled and you will be required to return the money.
  
- **NOTE: You must be registered for Second Block classes by Jan. 26, 2012, in order for your total credits to count toward your financial aid.**

**After January 26, 2012:\***

- If you **completely withdraw or reduce your credits after** Jan. 26, 2012 — You will not be required to return your university scholarships and/or university grants.
  
- If you **completely withdraw or reduce your credits after** Jan. 26, 2012 – Your Pell Grant and federal loans will be evaluated to determine how much you are required to repay.

\*If you drop any or all of your Winter 2012 classes after Jan. 26, 2012, you will receive “W” grades on your transcript. Additionally, if you withdraw from all of your Winter 2012 classes and it is an on-track semester, you will be considered withdrawn from the university and will be required to reapply and be readmitted to continue your enrollment at BYU-Idaho.
