

Approved Visitor Network Access Instructions

These instructions are for those visitors who have been approved and granted network access during their visit to BYU-Idaho and in conjunction to this approval have received their username and password.

Please follow these instructions in order to obtain configuration to the BYU-Idaho network:

Windows XP Machines -

When you arrive on campus you will find two wireless networks named *BYUI* and *BYUI-Setup*. The *BYUI-Setup* network is for the configuration of Windows XP machines only. After connecting to the *BYUI-Setup* you will be prompted to install an application and configuration assistant. These will help configure your system for network service. Once configured, you will not need to reconnect to the *BYUI-Setup* network again during this visit to BYU-Idaho.

All Other Operating Systems –

When you arrive on campus you will find two wireless networks named *BYUI* and *BYUI-Setup*. The *BYUI* network is for the configuration of all operating systems (with the exception of Windows XP). After connecting to *BYUI* you will be prompted to install an application and configuration assistant. These will help configure your system for network service. Once configured, you will not need to reconnect to the *BYUI* network again during this visit to BYU-Idaho.

The BYU-Idaho wireless networks are encrypted and authenticated. All traffic is monitored and filtered according to campus policy.
