

## Academic Renewal Petition

The Academic Renewal policy allows students to have their poor academic work, either at BYU–Idaho or another college or university, eliminated from the computation of credits and grade point averages in the student’s BYU–Idaho academic record. Academic Renewal only considers entire semesters to be eliminated. A student may not petition to have an individual class omitted.

The following criteria must be met to be considered for Academic Renewal:

1. At the time of the petition request, a minimum of four years must have elapsed since the most recent work to be disregarded was completed.
2. At the time of the petition request, the student must have completed one semester as a fulltime student (12 or more credits) at BYU–Idaho with a minimum grade point average of 2.5.
3. The semester(s) to be considered for Academic Renewal must have a grade point average below 2.0.

If the petition is approved, the semester(s) will not be removed from the transcript; however, those semester grades will be omitted from the student’s cumulative grade point average and their permanent academic record will be annotated to indicate that no courses taken during the disregarded semester(s), even if satisfactory, may apply towards graduation requirements.

Note: Academic Renewal may be utilized only once during a student’s career at BYU–Idaho. Students should also be aware that this policy may not be recognized at transfer institutions.
